



Music Monday: Alliteration

Alliteration is a long word that means something very simple: having words that start with the same letters. One way to write a poem with alliteration is to decide on a character's name, and then think of a word that starts with the same letter as the name, which describes the person. After that, try to use as many other words as you can in the poem that have the same letter! Here's a quick example:

Jazzy Jack

Jazzy Jack plays jazz piano
He sings "juh juh juh juh Jaaaaack!"
Join him for a song, won't you?
Generally he's a jovial guy.
